Sometimes, **o** and **e** work as partners to make the /oa/ sound. Let's say these examples:

toe

goe

This grapheme 'oe' makes the same sound as 'ow' as in 'low'.




Kit and Sam were walking through the forest. They thought that they heard some elephants but soon realised it could not be! The sound was coming from a group of dinosaurs further up.



"Look!" said Kit to Sam. "There is an apatosaurus. It looks so different to Steg but it goes slowly like Steg does."




"Yes, its name comes from the word lizard. In my sticker book, it is called a brontosaurus," commented Kit.









## Joe the Dino


