# Forces on a car

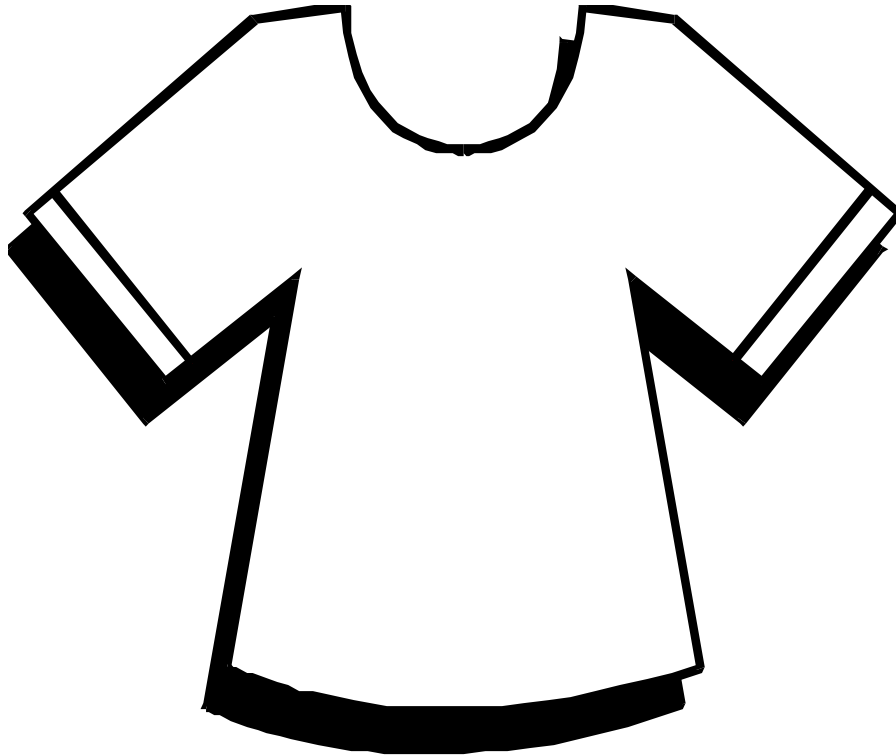




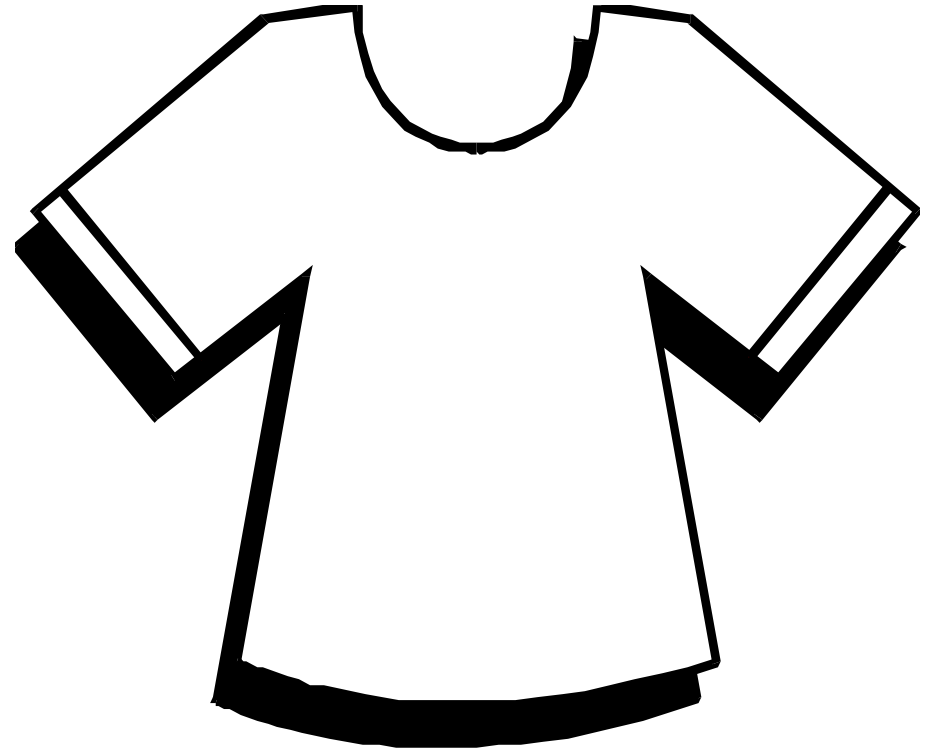

The team need an new uniform. Can you design this for them ? Remember to include the sponsors name on it or they'll get cross !



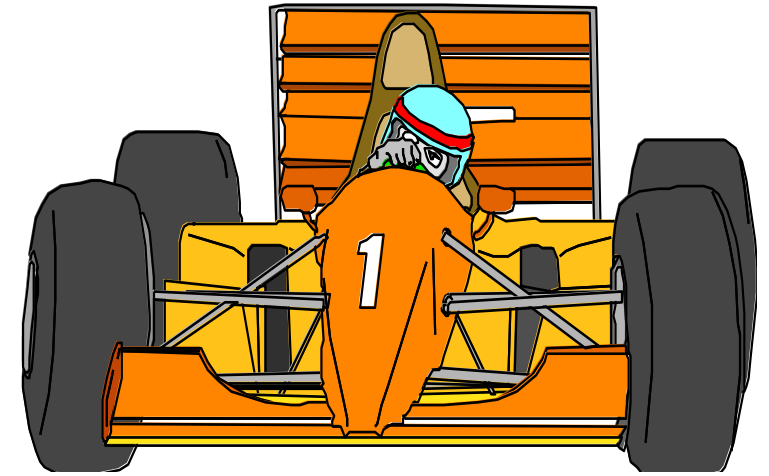

7. Write a story about life as a Driver or Manager, or perhaps a Mechanic.

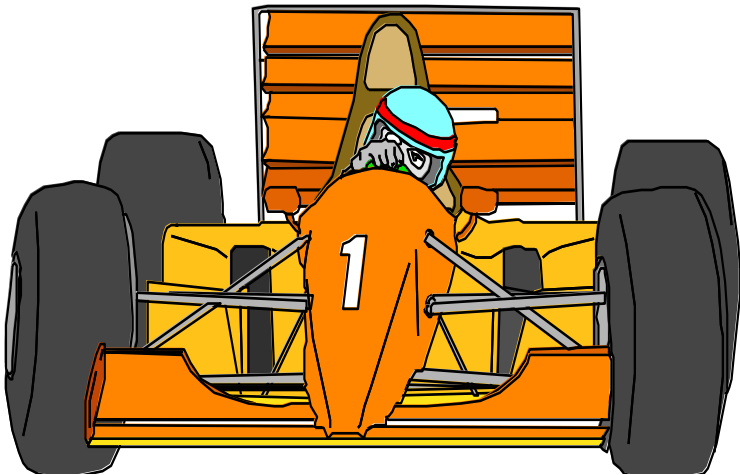


8. If a racing car cost 1 million pounds to buy work out how many weeks that would take you to save up and buy it and how old you would be when you bought it.
9. Anything else that you want to do for your project.

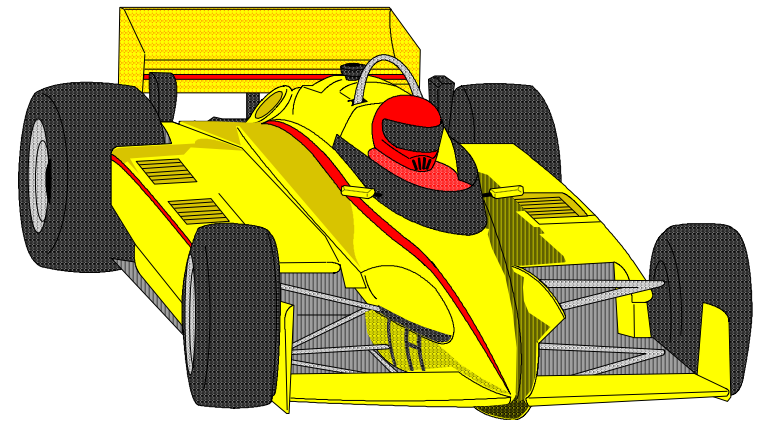


# Formula 1 Even More Other Ideas
