Dear Parents, Carers and Children

I do hope this Newsletter finds you safe and well...these are such strange times for us all. School has remained open for the last two weeks for a small number of children whose parents are key workers, but we are closing for the Easter break. However, I am pleased to say that by collaborating with the other Dorking Primary Schools we are able to offer provision for the children of our keyworkers at St Martin's School for the next two weeks until the start of next term.

As this period of isolation continues our priority is that our families feel as supported as possible. We have been uploading work and resources to our school website, along with sending out our Home Learning Letters. However, we are mindful that some families may not necessarily have access to technology for all of their children and that many are also trying to juggle their own working from home too! Therefore, our next Home Learning Letter will take a slightly different format: one which is clearer in expectation of how much to aim to do each day, with a balance of activities which need technology and ones which do not. In school, we will follow the same plans with the children who are attending as those which the children are following at home. All of the activities and learning will follow, as is practically possible, the topics and key areas of learning the children would have been covering had they been in school.

We have been in direct contact with some of our families already, as we are keen to support in any way we can. One of our great concerns is child welfare over this difficult period. 
