#### Over the last week we have been:

- Settling in to Year 2 and understanding the class and school rules, routines and expectations.

- Introducing SPAG vocabulary such as nouns and verbs.
- Practising counting to 20 and identifying 2 digit numbers using place value charts.
- Learning some basic painting skills such as how to create different types of brush strokes.

# Over the next two weeks we will be:

- Starting our work on the fable 'The Crow's Tale'. We will be building up some exciting vocabulary and using this to create interesting sentences.
- Learning about place value.
- Introducing our topic about Animals, including Humans, by learning about baby animals and how they grow.
- Introducing our topic about Castles.
- Making the most of the weather and catching up on some athletics skills.
