Over the last week we have been:

- Commencing our work on the fable 'The Crow's Tale'. We will be building up some exciting vocabulary and using this to create interesting sentences.
- Learning about place value.
- Continuing our topic about Animals, including Humans by learning about baby animals and how they grow.
- Learning about the features of a castle and re-creating the 'Castle and Sun' painting by Paul Klee.
- Making the most of the weather and catching up on some athletics skills.

Over the next two weeks we will be:

- Using our castles knowledge to write a non-chronological report.
- Improving our ability to 'talk maths and using our new mathematical vocabulary.
- Learning about the basic needs of animals including humans.
- Making motte and baily castles from Covid-safe cardboard boxes.
