Times Tables Rockstars

Children can access Times Tables Rockstars at home, using their school login. The 'Garage' section allows them to practise the tables based on their Y2 times table level and the initial Y3 assessment, which has been set by their teachers. However, they can access tables up to 12x12 in the other areas, such as 'Studio'. Please support your child with practising their tables on Times Tables Rockstars at home, as it is the speed of fact recall which is the key factor.
