



What's new in Maths?

We have just completed our first maths unit based on place value. We have covered investigating large numbers up to a million whilst also exploring negative numbers and Roman Numerals. Some children found **rounding large numbers** to 1000, 10,000 & 100,000 more challenging. We are working on our KIRF (key instant recall facts) based around times tables facts up to x12, including the inverse e.g. 144 divided by 12=12. The children now have a times table to work on for weekly testing. They should log into Rock Stars to practise at home.
