Spelling Patterns

J spelt -dge. The letter J is neve used for the j sound at the end of words in English. The sound -dge is used after the short vowel sounds e.g. hedge, pledge.

S sound spelt c. The soft c (s sound) is often spelt as c before e, I and y. e.g. race, ice and fancy

Just a reminder that it is intended that children should focus on these spelling patterns daily.
