Spelling Patterns

13th November: n sound spelt kn and (less often) gn at the beginning of words.

20th November: r sound spelt wr at the beginning of words.

There are no rules for when to use these spelling patterns.

Just a reminder that it is intended that children should focus on these spelling patterns daily.

Children should be using letter names to spell, not letter sounds. Please ask for letter names when practising spellings.
