## Reading Support at Home



Oxford Owl are offering eBooks which are levelled. Visit [www.oxfordowl.co.uk](http://www.oxfordowl.co.uk)


This is the page that you will see when you enter the website:

Enter the site Oxford Owl for Home and this screen will pop up


Then select Browse eBooks and it will take you to the following screen:



Then if you select the Oxford level next to the book band colour your child is currently reading and scroll down the page you will see a selection of eBooks. When you click on the eBook it will ask you to Login



When you click Login the following page will appear:



If you have used the site previously then login but if not then click the 'Join Us' link. It is free to join. Once you have joined then you will be able to access the eBooks. There are approximately 6 books to choose per level.
