## What will we be learning about in the next two weeks:

In **English**, we will be writing our own versions of Little Red Riding Hood (with a twist). In **Maths** we will be finishing our work about length and height, before moving onto position and direction.

In **R.E.** we will be continuing our topic on Islam; What is the Qur'an and the ritual of Salat.

In **P.S.H.E** we will be continuing our topic on relationships.

In **Science** we will be continuing our topic 'The Apprentice gardener' and investigating what is happening to the seeds we planted, recording the changes we see.

In Topic we will be continuing our unit 'Sensational Safari', comparing the landscapes and people of Kenva with those in Britain.

## Homework

This week we are restarting homework in Year 2. As before, we will be setting a 15 minute piece of work each Friday to be handed in the following Wednesday. We will be setting a grammar sheet on Teams which can be printed out if needed, to avoid hard copies being sent back into school. We will however, try to set sheets that can be completed on a blank, lined piece of paper (or in homework books). Each assignment may have more than one sheet, but just complete what you can in the 15 minutes.

We are starting today with a sheet on apostrophes for contraction, so your spelling work from last week will help you with this.
