Maths

The next block for our maths will be telling the time using analogue and digital clocks to the nearest minute. This means that children should be familiar with am and pm, how the clock face works - past and to the hour, using fractions to help them to link with quarters of an hour and the 5 times table to help them to count around the clock. Please have a look at time with your child/children in your everyday routine, as this will help them with their learning at school.
