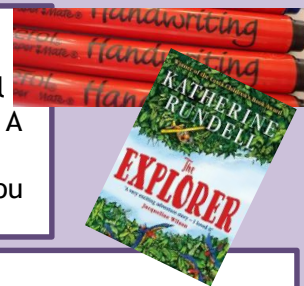
Some of the children's exercise books will be going straight up to Y5.
