**Maths** - applying skills learnt earlier in the year to problem solving and investigative work, with the aim of revising and consolidating prior learning.

English - Writing stories of mystery and suspense.

Spelling - Revision of rules:

Words ending in -ant, -ance/- Words with the /long 'ei' sound. **Geography** - Continuing our topic on Sustainability and Climate Change, focusing on food waste and thinking about how to make positive changes to save the planet.

**RE** - finding out about Hindu sacred writings, and exploring how Hindu beliefs are expressed in Hindu stories.

**Design** - In Art/DT, we will be beginning work as designers in the style of Vivienne Westwood. The children will be planning to reinvent an article of clothing. Soon they will bring home a copy of their design brief. We hope that you can support their design by supplying an old piece of clothing, plus some materials, which can be reused. A visit to charity shops would be ideal!
