PSHE sessions based on "Changing Me" continue.

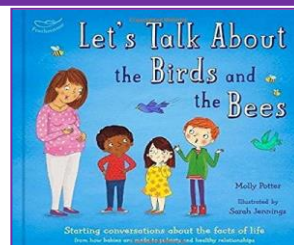
