Maths Update from Mrs Tubb

What a challenging year it has been for your children and yet we are so proud how they, and you, have managed to continue learning in maths. We have had some very positive feedback regarding the resources we have been using in maths both during lockdowns and when children are self-isolating. Thank you once again for all the support you have given your children. This has helped enormously and amazingly enough all year groups have been able to deliver the whole maths curriculum this year, which places us in a very strong position from September.

We have also made some exciting changes, which your children may have told you about, to help us continue to focus on number sense, using the NCETM ready to progress materials delivered during the 15 min daily fluency lesson. This has helped enormously to plug any gaps any children may have experienced during the year, and we will be continuing to use these resources in September to help bridge any COVID-19 gap, after comprehension transition between year groups.

Several parents have requested we hold another Maths meeting for parents to demonstrate some practical ways to help your child and clarify how we teach your children maths. We have not forgotten you and as soon as restrictions allow, we will be popping a date in the diary.

Meanwhile please make maximum use of the website where you will find support booklets which show the coverage and methods use for each year group. You can find this in curriculum/maths/maths support booklets.

Just a reminder you will also find the KIRFS for each year group in the maths section on the website and we will be continuing to encourage all children, in September, to spend some time each day doing some Maths and learning these key facts alongside their daily reading.

We have also renewed our subscription to TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) as so many of the children enjoy using this site to help them learn their times tables.

Stationery Shop


