You will undoubtedly notice a few changes in the table above.

In order to support our transition arrangements, as the children move year groups and sites, several of the teachers are moving up with their current year group. The teachers will know where the children in the year are, in terms of their learning, and will join an existing member of a year group who will know exactly where they need to get to!

Mrs Ottaway will not be class based at all, but will continue to lead our Learning Outside the Classroom provision as part of our focus on the well-being and mental health of the children. In addition to this, Miss Winslade will have time out of class at Leigh, to undertake weekly outdoor learning sessions for the children there. Both Mr Wade and Mrs Deeks will support across all years, within their respective key stages, leading groups and interventions as part of our plans to support the children a part of our Covid Recovery Curriculum. To help with this staffing structure for the next year, we have recruited two new staff members to join our teaching team. Miss Ella Tennent is joining Year 2 at Leigh and Miss Jess Sollom will become Mrs Bradby's new job share partner in Year 5. They will both be visiting the school and meeting the children prior to the end of this school year - we very much look forward to welcoming them to the North Downs team!

We will all miss her incredibly and we thank her so much for all her hard work and dedication.
