Dear Parents and Carers

You may be aware that on Sunday 29th November the government made a decision to update guidance with regard to this Christmas period. It included the possibility of audiences attending school events such as nativities in Tier 2 areas, subject to appropriate safeguards. As the need to socially distance would still have been compulsory, it would be have been impossible for us to achieve fair and equitable access for parents, without the need to repeat the performance numerous times. This was simply neither fair nor practical given the other restrictions and procedures we are also having to adhere to currently. Ordinarily, this week would have been the week of our junior Christmas production, followed by our infant Nativities in Church next week. As such, we have continued with the plans that we had agreed before this very late change to DfE guidance; and actually, without the time taken up by rehearsals, the children have continued full pace with their learning. This has been a distinct bonus following the lockdown of last academic year. The filming for our end of term video has taken place over the last two days and I would like to say a huge thank you to Mr Berwick and Mrs Knapp, as well as the children, for undertaking most of this outside in rather cold and wet weather!
