The pencil case is classroom user friendly, as it will fit into the school trays provided to each child, and will contain all of your child's daily needed stationery.



School will continue to provide stationery, but many children like to have their own. The kit will not include glue or scissors; each class provides these.

The pencil case will contain; a ruler, an eraser, a pencil sharpener, colouring pencils, a hand writing pen or pencil (depending on year group), a green pen for class editing, a highlighter pen, wipe board pen and eraser. All items are of various colours and at a cost of £9.50.
