





As part of the determination the following change will be implemented:

8. Changes to published admission numbers (PANs)
Ashford Park - increase in Reception PAN from 60 to 90

Cranmere - increase in Reception PAN from 60 to 90
Farncombe CofE - increase in Reception PAN from 40 to 50
The Greville - increase in Reception PAN from 30 to 60
Hinchley Wood - increase in Reception PAN from 60 to 90
Hurst Park - increase in Reception PAN from 30 to 60
Manby Lodge - increase in Reception PAN from 60 to 90
Milford - increase Reception PAN from 50 to 60
North Downs - introduction of Year 3 PAN of 4
South Camberley - increase in Reception PAN from 110 to 120
Stoughton - increase in Reception PAN from 60 to 90
West Byfleet - increase in Reception PAN from 60 to 90
Worplesdon - introduction of a Year 3 PAN of 30

Any person or body who considers that any aspect of these admission arrangements is unlawful or not in compliance with the School Admissions Code or relevant law relating to admissions, can make an objection to the Office of the Schools Adjudicator. Objections must be referred by 30 June 2015 and further information on how to make an objection can be obtained from the Office of the Schools Adjudicator website.
