Spelling Rules

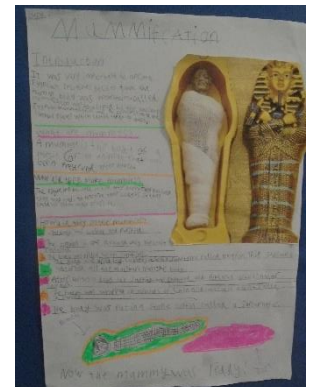
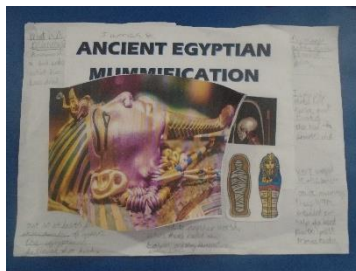
Week beginning 31st October - the /ai/ sound spelled 'ei', 'eigh' or 'ey'
