Dog Fouling: we have received a strong complaint from a Brockham resident about incidences of dog fouling opposite the school site at Brockham. Part of their letter stated,

"This is disgusting, it used to happen when the school had a dog park on school premises and now it has moved across the road. Why should the residents of those houses have to clear up after somebody else's animals? Please could you request parents to clear up after their dogs and if they can't because they have their children with them, then don't bring the dog with them."

We add our request that you show adequate consideration for your village and our school neighbours.

E-Safety Rules: this letter and attached forms came home on ParentMail on Friday 12th June, and we ask that if you have not yet done so, you sign and return the form/s to us on Monday 29th.

As a school we take the issue of e-safety very seriously. We want children to enjoy using ICT, but at the same time we believe they must be made aware of the potential dangers involved and understand how to use the internet safely. We know that this is a concern shared by most parents today.
