...will be busy! Here is what we are planning to study during the first two weeks:

**English** - Revising our skills in comprehension. Starting Biographical Writing. We will be tying this in with our work in science and focussing on the life of Charles Darwin.

**EGPS**- Revision of the basic rules covered this school year.

**Maths** - Statistics: interpreting and constructing line graphs and pie charts, in addition general revision work

**Science** - Working on Evolution and Inheritance, including biographies of experts in this field.

**RE** - we will be looking at Hinduism throughout the summer term, beginning with investigating what helps Hindus to worship.

**History** - considering the impact of the reign of Alfred the Great.

**Art** - continuing our work based on Lowry.

**PSHE** -enjoying the text Under the Lights which addresses some of the trials of being 11 and at school!
