## The last two weeks of Year 2:

- In **English**, we are consolidating our SPaG and dictionary use, looking at word classes, and tenses.
- In **Maths**, we are finishing with position and direction.
- In **Science**, we are completing the term of 'Living Things' by checking our understanding of the unit and exploring local British habitats.
- In **Topic**, we will be comparing packing lists for trips to hot and cold places - ready for the summer holidays!

## Spelling patterns

We have practised the /er/ sound spelt 'or'. This comes most often after a 'w'.
