One of our ongoing successes is our Year 6 Stationery Shop. As we rapidly approach the end of this school year and the exciting move to the new academic year, the Year 6 stationery shop would like to take this opportunity to offer you the chance to pre-order a stationery kit for the new term. The pencil case is classroom user friendly, as it will fit into the school trays provided to each child, and will contain all of your child's daily needed stationery. These are available for children in Years 3 to 5. We will be making alternative arrangements for next year's Year 6 pupils and we will write to the separately with further details. School will continue to provide stationery, but many children like to have their own. The kit will not include glue or scissors; each class provide these.



The pencil case will contain; a ruler, an eraser, a pencil sharpener, colouring pencils, a hand writing pen or pencil (depending on year group), a green pen for class editing, a highlighter pen, wipe board pen and eraser. • Dorking Schools Swimming Gala

On 20th April, a team of children from Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 took part in the Dorking schools Swimming Gala held at the Priory School. The children competed in races in freestyle, breaststroke, backstroke, butterfly and three relays. With some good performances and 3rd position overall, just one point behind the 2nd placed school.

Dorking Schools Year 5 and 6 Boys Cricket Tournament

On 6th June our team of Years 5 and 6 boys travelled to Newdigate Cricket Club to compete in the Dorking school's tournament. They played extremely well, guided by excellent captaincy from Monty in Year 6, winning all of their 5 games. They go on to represent Dorking on 12th July at the Surrey County Final at Sunbury Cricket club.

Dorking Schools Year 5 and 6 Girls Cricket Tournament

The girl's team took part in their Dorking tournament at Newdigate Cricket Club on 9th June. They had been practising hard at our popular school club and this showed in some excellent bowling. They won two of their five games losing the other three by a very narrow margin. They finished 4th overall.

• Dorking Schools Year 4 Tri Golf Tournament

All of the children in Year 4, and all the Dorking schools, have been enjoying 3 sessions of FREE golf coaching with the golf professional from Betchworth Golf Club. They have thoroughly enjoyed this. 10 children were then selected (5 boys and 5 girls) to compete against the other Dorking schools in the Tri Golf Festival at Betchworth Golf Club on 8th June. The children worked well as a team and played some very good shots to win the tournament by over 150 points.

Dorking Schools Year 3 and 4 Tennis Tournament

36 children from Years 3 and 4 have been attending the tennis club and from these eight, 2 teams of 4 children, went on to represent North Downs in the Dorking Tennis Tournament. This was held on 26th June at Dorking Tennis Club. Both our teams played really well with the A team finishing in 1st position and the B team in 3rd.

A team of Year 5 and 6 children played in the Dorking Rounders tournament at Powell on 19th June. They won all their games in their pool and qualified for the final. In a very close match they lost to Powell by one rounder to finish 2^{nd} overall.
