## Year 3 Expectations

- In Year 3, children are encouraged to take greater responsibility for themselves. This includes coming into class independently, as well as taking accountability for their own learning so they are aware of their own improvement and progression.
- Uniform expectations:

  - Children should bring their reading book and homework diary, water bottle, lunch box (if required), fruit snack, and a coat (<u>need these at</u> <u>all times</u>).
  - Children may bring a named pencil case as long as it fits in their tray!

- No jewellery (earrings must be removed before school or by your child before the lesson).
  - ▶ Long hair tied back.
  - ▶ Please write in your child's diary if they cannot undertake PE.
  - ▶ This term: shorts and short sleeved t-shirts for Gymnastics please!

#### Spellings:

- ► Spelling patterns and National Curriculum words sent home weekly on Thursday to learn and be tested on.
- Spellzone is encouraged for practising the patterns and NC words.
- Children will receive homework (English, Maths, or Topic based) on Thursday to return by the following Tuesday.
  - ▶ They should spend up to 30 minutes on this.
  - Any help can be given and is greatly appreciated!





## Homework: Reading

- Read every night up to 15mins.
- ▶ 10 mins reading, 5 mins questions.
  - Reading tips (see diary: 'Practice Reading Skills' page).
  - Reading for understanding.
  - Quality rather than quantity.
  - ► Children are encouraged to write in their own diary each night, noting the title and page/chapter they read to.
  - Write END: this helps us know when children have finished their reading books and are ready to swap for a new one.



### Homework: Maths

- Please attempt some Maths daily.
- ► We focus on half termly Year 3 KIRFs which can be found in the diary 'Key Instant Recall Facts' pages and also on the school website.
- ▶ We have a school push on Times Tables as children are now tested at the end of Year 4 so there will be weekly tables tests.
  - ► The expectation is that children will know all tables up to their 12s by the end of Year 4.
  - ▶ Little and often!
