Welcome to Year 3!

We have been really pleased with how well the children have settled into Year 3, coping with all the changes and challenges starting Key Stage 2 provides. This year is full of exciting learning opportunities and we look forward to sharing these with you all during the year.

The next two weeks:

- In **English**, we are learning about writing instructions.
- In Maths, we are learning about place value, specifically mastering number to 1,000.
- In **Science**, we are looking at forces and magnetism.
- In Topic, we have travelled back thousands of years to visit Ancient Egypt!
- In Music, we are learning about writing Music down.
- In Computing, we start the year looking at online safety.
- In P.S.H.E., we are learning about our first Puzzle piece, 'Being Me in My World'.

Homework

The first homework for Year 3 will be set next Thursday (21st September) and will be a spelling activity about days, months and seasons. The following week (28th September) we will be setting a two week History homework, asking the children to research and make a poster about Ancient Egypt.

The first Spellings list will also go home on the 21st.

Spelling patterns

We are currently in the process of checking which Year 2 common exception words the children can both read and write.

We will send home a sheet identifying any words for you to work on together, which we will also practice together in school.

Swimming

As you should now be aware - the first lessons were this week! - Year 3 will be enjoying weekly swimming lessons this term, happening on **Wednesdays** and **Thursdays** depending on their group. Notes have been sent home to let you know which day your child swims on; It's Wednesday for those who are still in the earlier stages of learning to swim and Thursdays for those who are more confident.

P.E.

This term, P.E. will take place on **Tuesdays** only, as Year 3 swimming session will make up their second P.E. lesson. Therefore, the children only need to wear P.E. kit to school on Tuesdays. This will change after Christmas, when we hold a pause on swimming.

Additionally, for P.E. this term, the children are doing Gymnastics. It would be most helpful to them if they could wear shorts and short sleeves for this.

Finally, a reminder from the Newsletter.
Children who have pierced ears must either remove their earrings before coming into school, or be able to take them out themselves before the lesson starts. We cannot put plasters over piercings nor take piercings out for children.
