Well done to all those children who have been reading and completing maths daily, we have loved giving out so many house points to those children! Please remember to read with questioning and complete daily KIRF's, signing/initialling both columns. Please also remind your child to remember to bring their reading diary to school every day.

Thank you for all your help and support with the settling into Year 2, we are so proud of the children's efforts to adapt to the new school year!

The next two weeks:

- In English, we are continuing our work on the four types of sentences, and will be moving on to poetry
- In Maths, we begin of addition and subtraction topic focussing on 2 digit numbers.
- In Science, we will continue our learning about the properties of materials and material suitability
 finding what makes the bounciest ball!
- In **Topic**, we are learning about some key figures in the development of communication technology.
