Settling into Year 3

- In **Topic**, continuing to explore Ancient Egypt.
- In D.T., we will learn about pneumatics.
- In Computing, we will now apply our online safety skills whilst using the computers in school.
- In French, we are learning about 'Les

 too.

Multiplication Tables

We have now started our weekly testing of the times tables. At the end of Year 4, all children take the national 'Multiplication Tables Check' which covers all the tables from 2s-12s. Our weekly tests help to develop children's knowledge and memory of the tables and we do really push the fact that knowing your tables means instant recall, not working each answer out each time. TT Rockstars is a really good way to make practising these fun and all children can log on using their school login details.

Homework

The first homework for Year 3 was set yesterday, and is due in on Tuesday 3rd October. The first set of Spellings also went home yesterday.

Next Thursday, (5th October) we will be setting a two week History homework, asking the children to research and make a poster about Ancient Egypt, alongside the weekly Spellings homework.
