Curriculum Day

We had a wonderful day yesterday at Leigh, learning about the compass points including making our own, practising direction with Beebots; and making 3D maps. We hope your children enjoyed the day, and we are so proud of them for all their hard work throughout the day!

The next two weeks:

- In English, we will be writing recounts of events, looking at a half term activity, Curriculum Day or Bonfire Night.
- In Maths, we will be continuing our addition and subtraction topic, now adding 2 two digit numbers.
- In Science, we are starting the remaining portion of our Materials unit by learning about how we can manipulate different materials.
- In Topic, following our fantastic curriculum Day, we will be continuing our mapping unit, flying across the continents and oceans.
- In **Art**, we dive into some expressive painting, exploring colour and mark-making.
- In P.S.H.E., we will start Jigsaw Piece 2: 'Celebrating Difference'.
- In P.E., we will begin Gymnastics look out Simone Biles!

Spelling patterns

We have been looking at the spelling patterns for the 's' sound spelt with a 'c'.

Spelling rule: often comes before 'e', 'i', and 'y'. We have also learnt about the 'n' sound spelt as 'kn' or 'gn'.
