What we are learning:

English - We have just completed a week dedicated to grammar, looking at relative clauses, synonyms and antonyms and the active and passive voice. Next week we start out unit on newspaper reports, using WW2 as our subject.

Maths - continuing our work on fractions; this continues until the end of term.

Art - We are starting a unit on printing techniques and we will be producing propaganda posters in the style of those seen in WW2. See below for a plea!

RE - We have started our unit called 'CHRISTIANITY: What do Christians believe about the Messiah - and why is it good news?'

History - We have started our unit on WW2 by looking at how the end of the First World War played a part in the events which led to the start of war in 1939.
