GOVERNING BODY OF NORTH DOWNS SCHOOL - PARENT GOVERNOR VACANCIES

We are seeking nominations for parents to stand for election as parent governors of North Downs Primary School. The school currently has two vacancies for a Parent Governor on its Governing Body. Nominations for Parent Governor Vacancies are made by parents of pupils registered at the school. Parent Governors serve for a term of four years irrespective of how long their child remains as a registered pupil of the school.

Parents are invited to submit nominations to the school using the attached nomination form. Each nominee must be proposed and seconded by parents of registered pupils presently attending the school and the nominee must also be a parent and signify his or her willingness to stand for election. Should there be more nominations than vacancies, a secret ballot will be held. However, please do not let this discourage you from considering this role. If it becomes apparent that a ballot is necessary we will notify you to see if you are willing to continue with the process.

Please note - a person is disqualified from election or appointment as a parent governor of a school if they are an elected member of the Local Authority or if they work at the school for more than 500 hours (i.e. for more than one-third of the hours of a full-time equivalent) in a school year (at the time of election or appointment).

The nomination form should be printed and the completed form must be returned to the Clerk to the Governors by noon on <u>Friday 19th January 2024.</u> No nomination will be accepted after that date/time. Those nominated to stand for election may enclose with their nomination form a short personal statement about themselves, of not more than 100 words. Statements will be circulated to parents should a ballot prove necessary. If the number of nominations received is less than the number of vacancies, the person nominated will be appointed without a ballot. If the number of candidates exceeds the number of vacancies a secret ballot will be held (after confirmation that all candidates wish to enter the ballot). Details of the secret ballot will be forwarded to all parents.
