Please come in wearing your PE kit on these days:

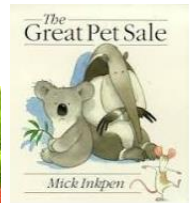
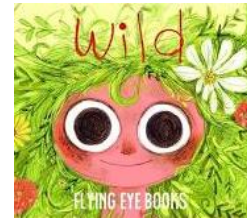
Penguins - Monday and Wednesday
