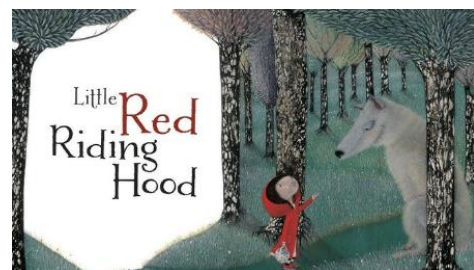


We are Learning:
