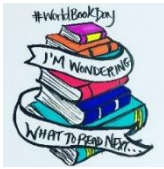


World Book Day

What we are learning

- English - Writing a biography for an explorer. E.g. Neil Armstrong
- English - Superheroes/ real and fictional with a focus on Supertato
- Phonics - 'ee' as 'ea' / 'e-e' / 'ie' / 'ey' 'y'
- Maths - Measuring objects, comparing objects, measuring in cm.
- Science - Looking for signs of spring and investigations on materials.
- History - Explorers, Neil Armstrong, Amelia Earhart and Christopher Columbus
- RE - Parables
- D.T Healthy food; exploring what different dips taste like
- Computing - Using computers to create artwork
- P.E - Gymnastics and Outdoor games
